## The Second Chance Foundation extends tax filing and calculations support improving taxation awareness

Scarborough – Throughout February 27, 2025 to May 1, 2025, The Second Chance Foundation (TSCF) offers tax filing support at their main office, as well as Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) and Pathways locations. Volunteers, students and experienced professionals are providing knowledge and assistance required and enable informed and accurate tax filing and tax calculations decisions.

Legal economic practices, adherence and maintained aligning to fair and transparent tax policies enable support for informed and safe economic decision making. Therefore, it is important that individuals and communities are informed about their responsibilities and legal obligations as well as benefits that they are to gain in the form of refunds and tax credits.

In 2025, The Second Chance Foundation (TSCF) along with other community service organizations are expecting to process around 1,800 tax filings doubling from the previous year of 2024.

Locations extend from The Second Chance Foundation's (TSCF) Main Office and Training and Recreational Programs Centre (3171 Eglinton Ave. East, Scarborough, Ontario, M1J 2G8) to Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) (90-2700 Dufferin St., Toronto, Ontario, M6B 4J3) and to Pathways (25 Neilson Rd., Scarborough, Ontario, M1E 5E1).

The year-round tax clinic is operated out of The Second Chance Foundation's (TSCF) main office until the end of each November, paused for holiday season break during the month of December and resumes in mid-January of each new taxation cycle year.

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The Second Chance Foundation serves Scarborough, Toronto and GTA area's marginalized, racialized, underhoused, unhoused, incarcerated, formerly incarcerated women and their children, and women transitioning back into the community from the criminal justice system. Operating since 2017, the organization delivers food security, clothing and other needed items, as well as training, programs and workshops to uphold material, social, cultural, as well as general wellbeing needs.
